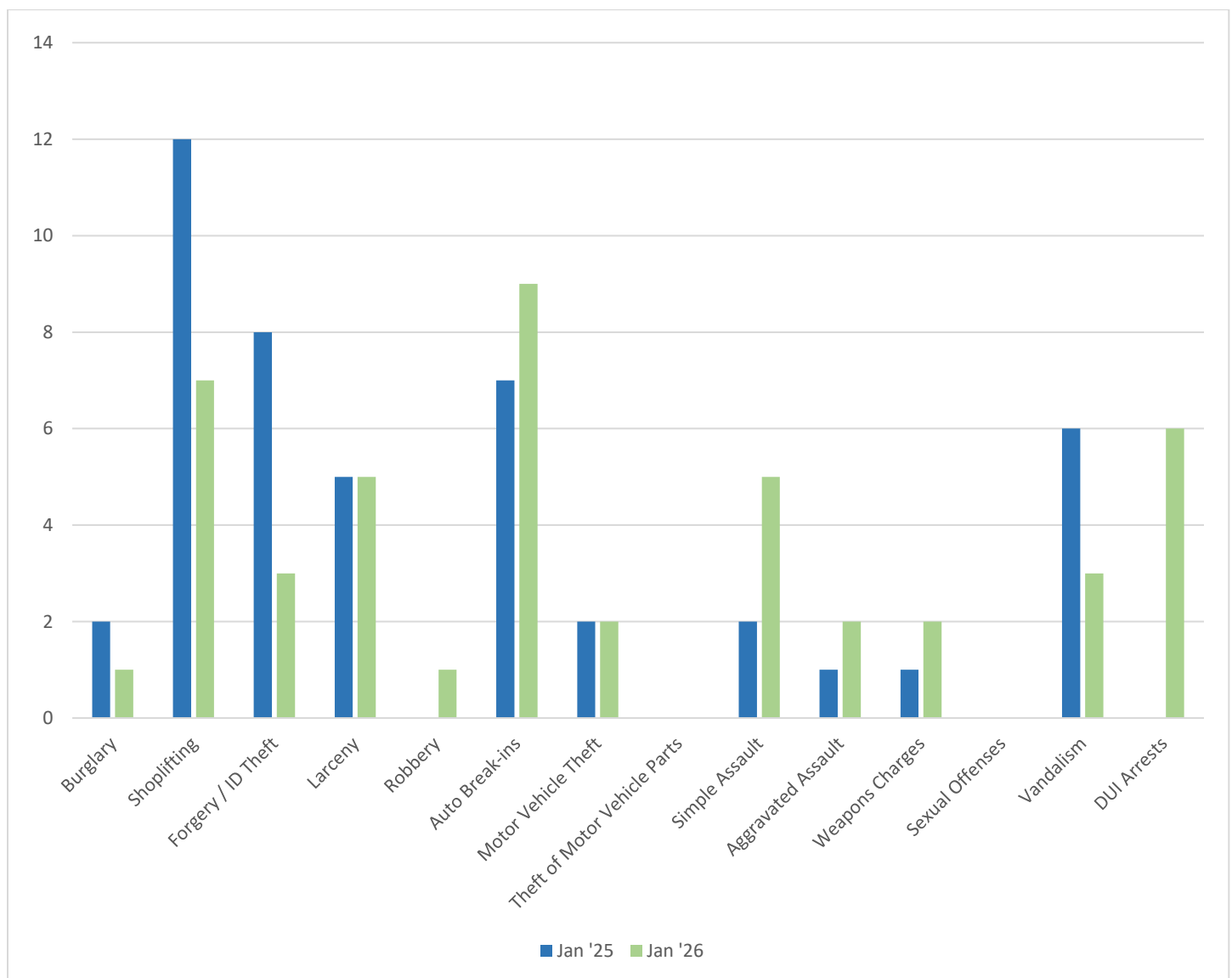

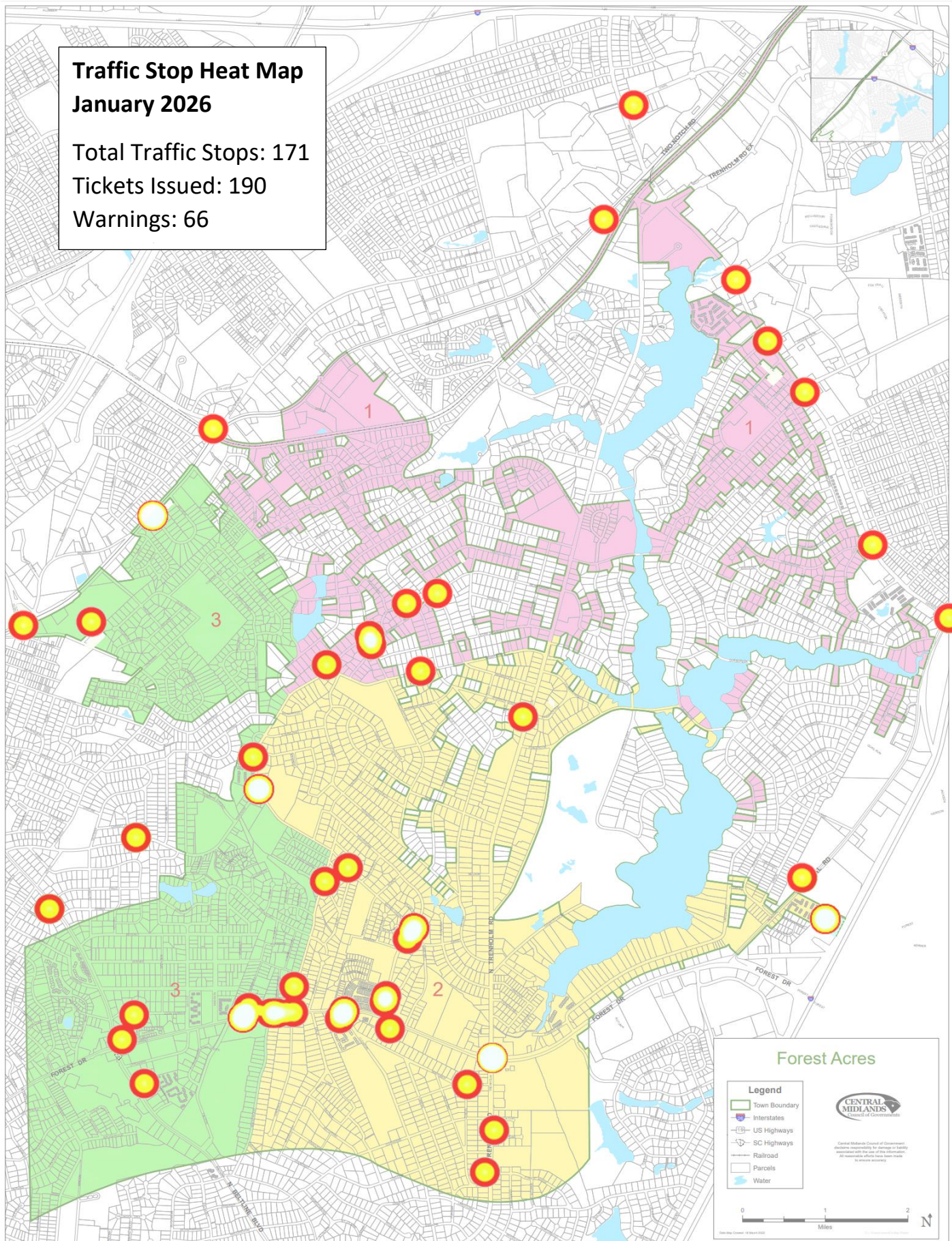

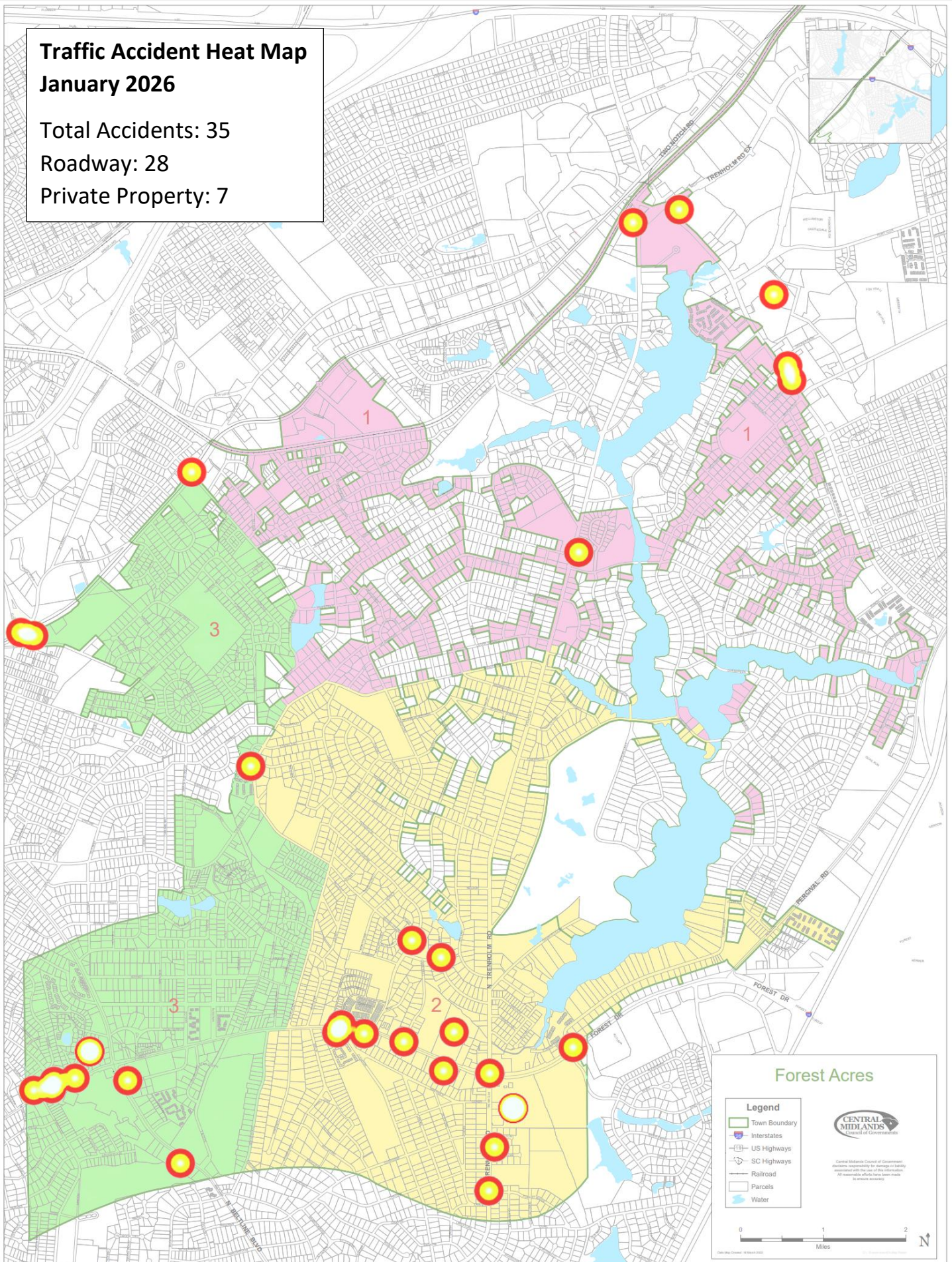


Traffic Accident Heat Map January 2026

Accident Summary

- 35 total accidents for the month.
- 17 fewer than last month.
- 28 Roadway Accidents (34 previous month).
- 7 Private Property (18 previous month).
- Primary Causes of roadway accidents were **Failure to Yield** (11), **Following Too Close** (4), **Improper Lane Change** (3) and **Disregarding a Traffic Control Device** (3).
- Primary Causes of private property accidents were **Improper Backing** (5).
- 10 of the roadway accidents happened on Forest Dr., 5 on Decker Blvd., and 3 on Trenholm Rd.
- 6 of the 7 private property accidents happened at businesses on Forest Drive.
