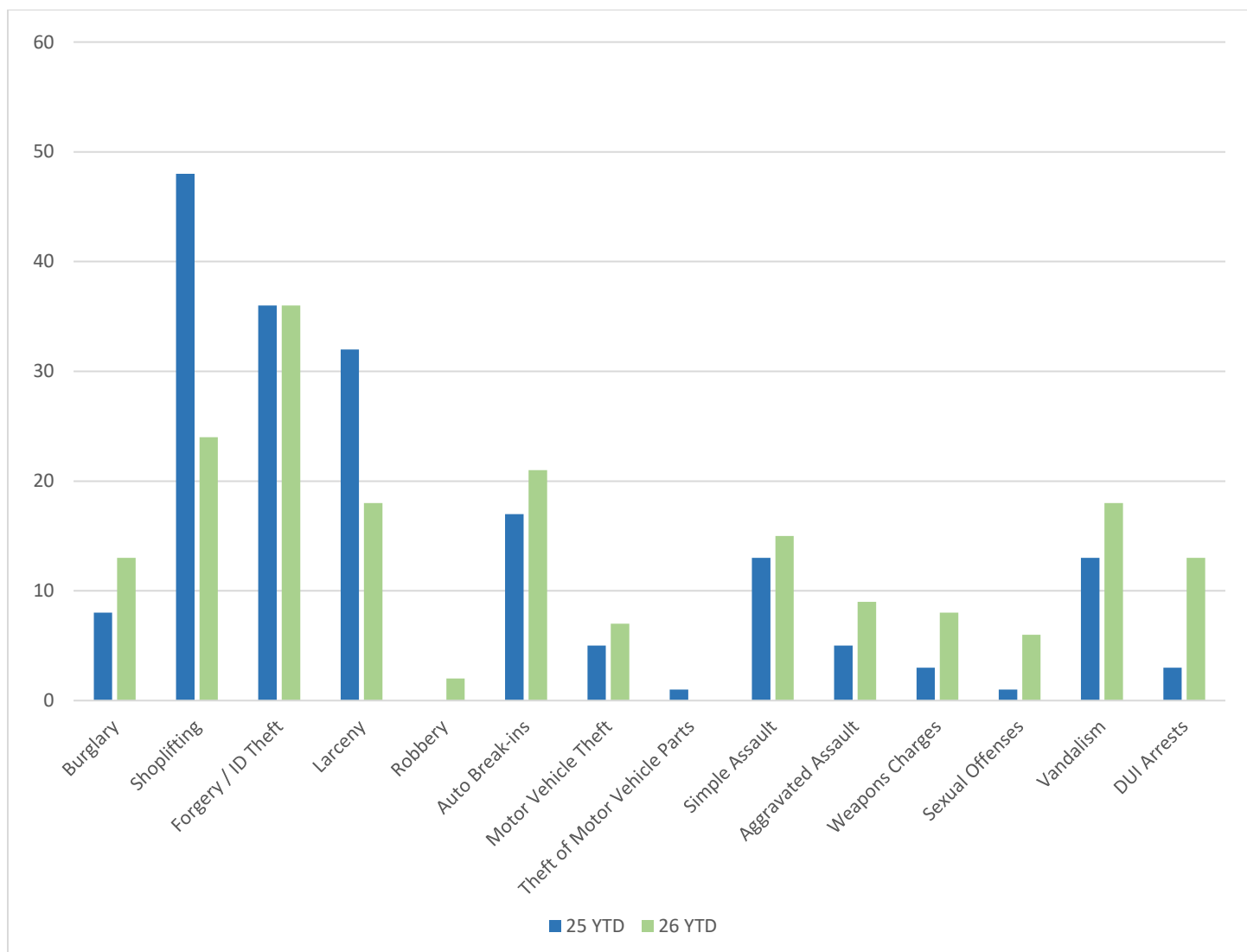

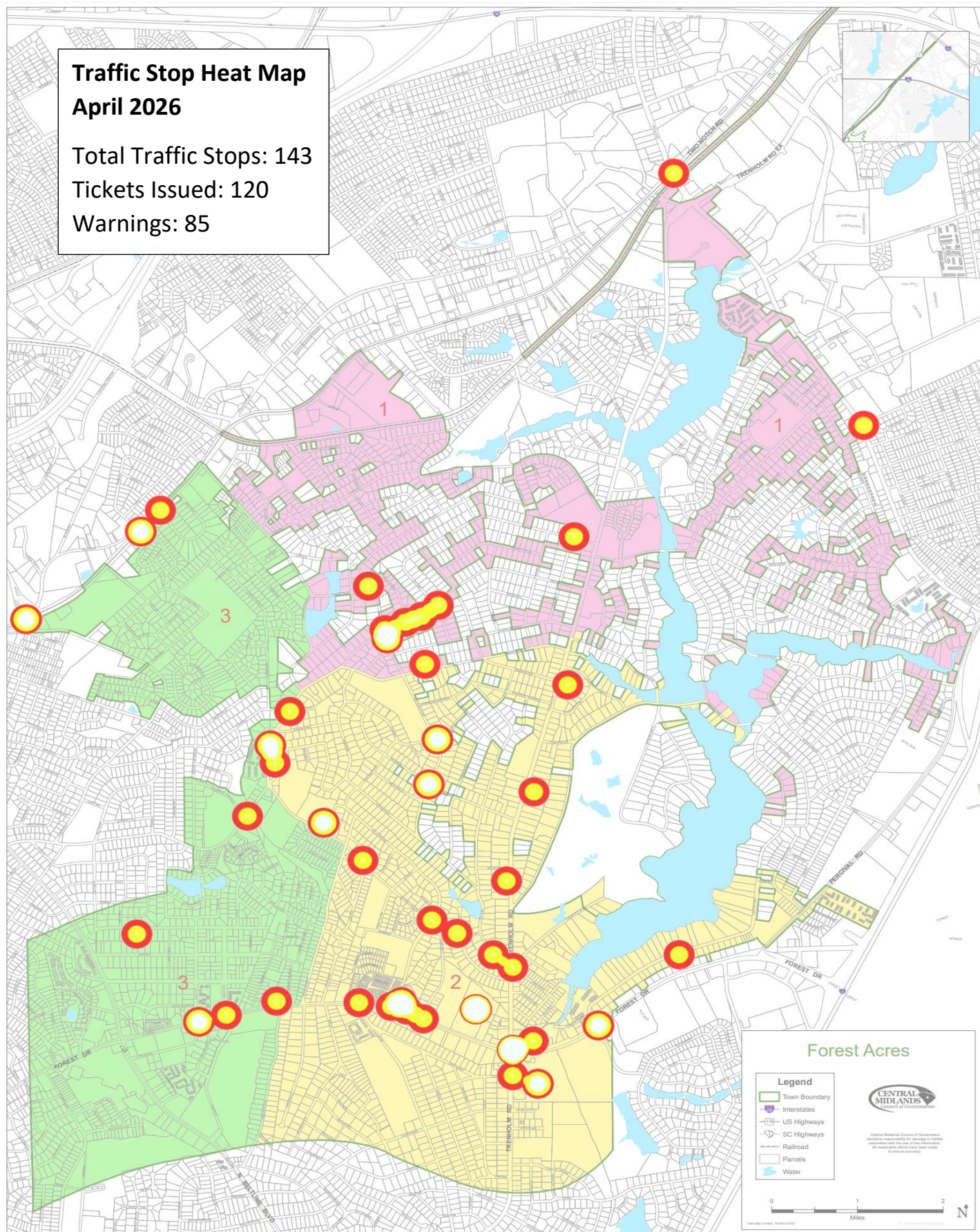

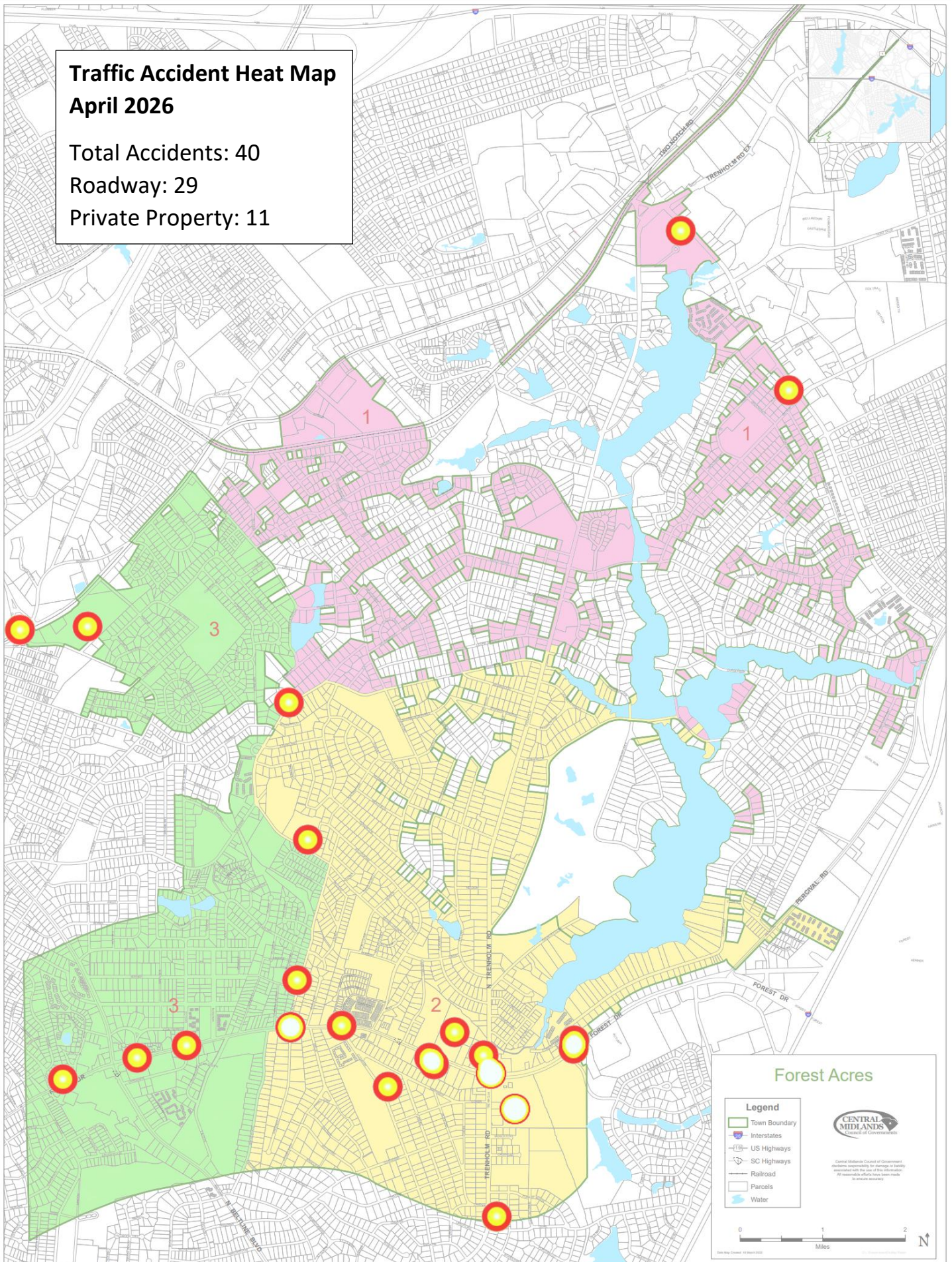

## Accident Summary

- 40 total accidents in the month.
- 2 more than last month.
- 29 Roadway Accidents (same as last month).
- 11 Private Property (9 last month).
- Primary Causes of roadway accidents were **Failure to Yield** (10), **Followed Too Close** (7), **Improper Lane Change** (5), **Improper Operation** (2), and **Improper Turn** (2).
- Primary Causes of private property accidents were **Improper Backing** (8).
- 16 of the roadway accidents happened on Forest Dr., 3 on N. Trenholm Dr., and 3 on Decker Blvd.
- 7 of the 11 private property accidents happened at businesses on Forest Drive.
