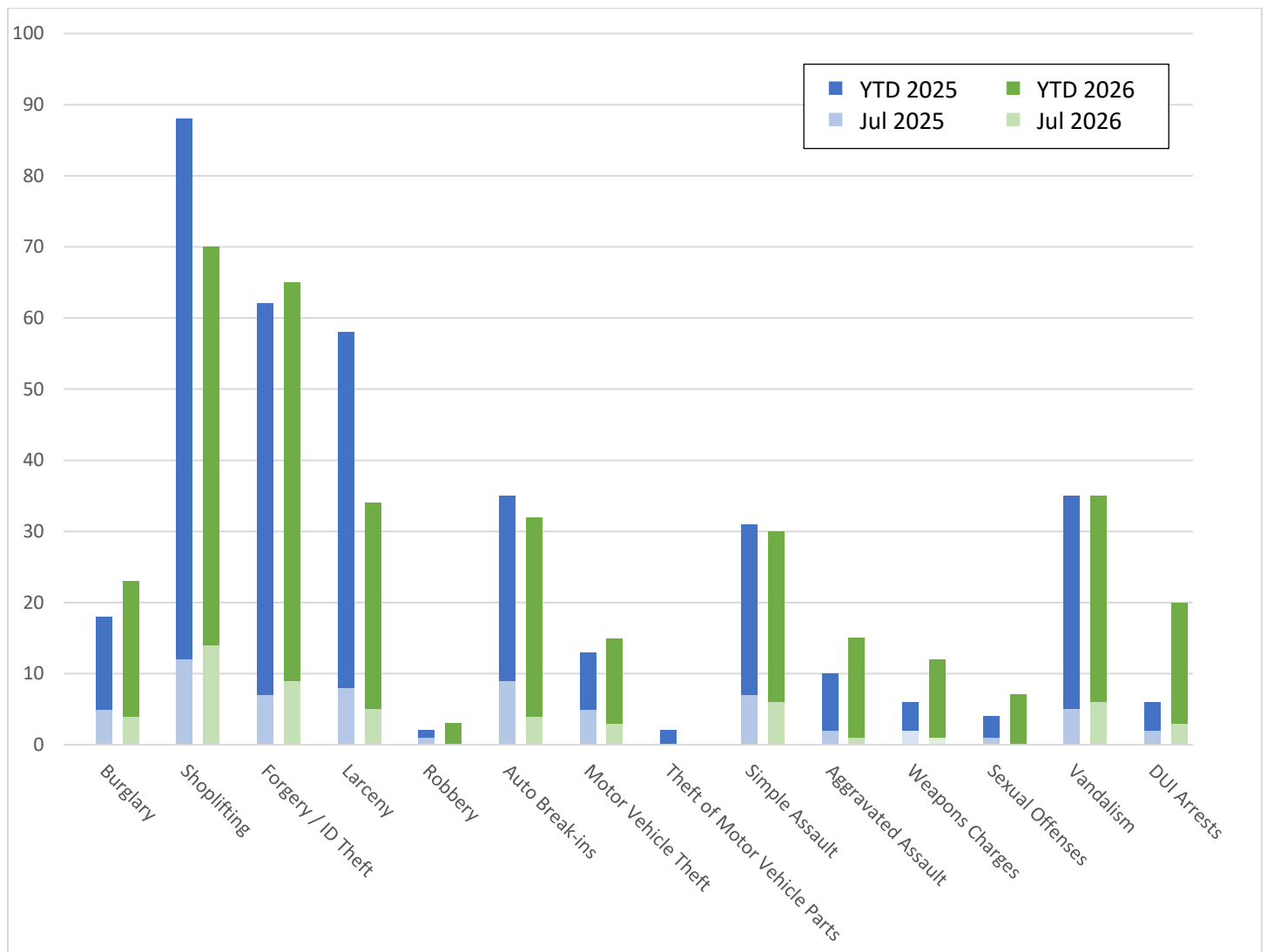

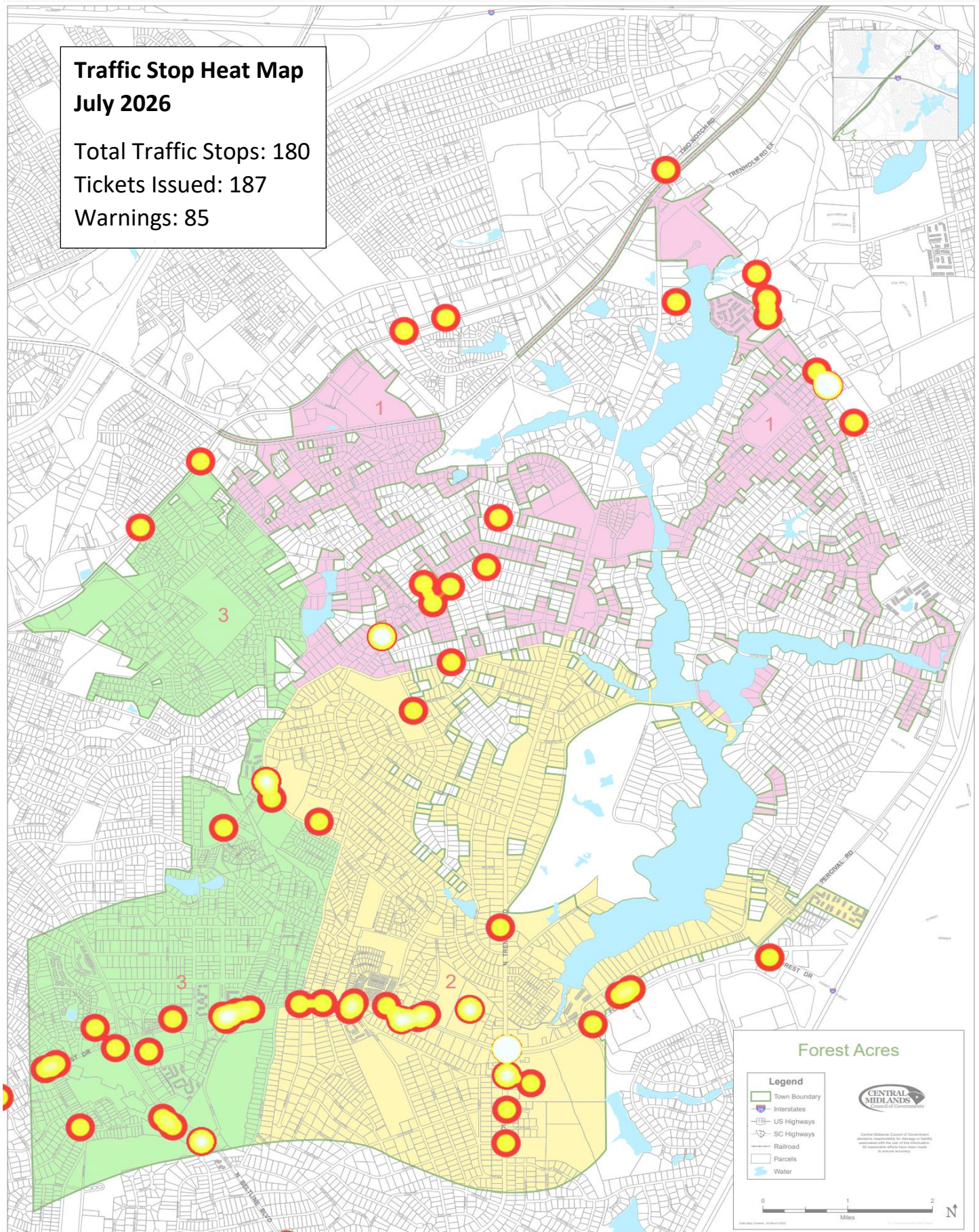

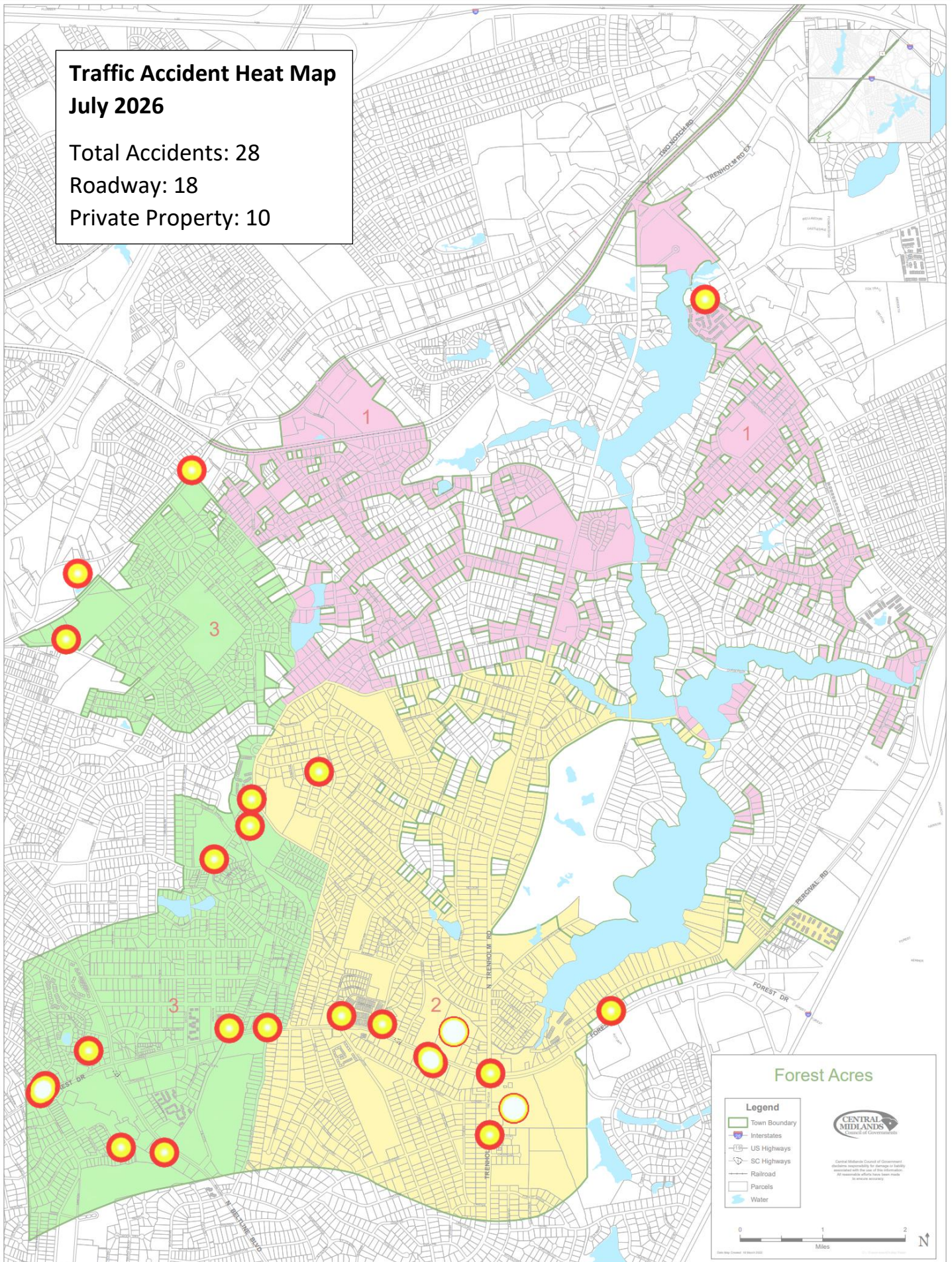

Accident Summary

- 28 total accidents in the month.
- 5 more than last month.
- 18 Roadway Accidents (13 last month).
- 10 Private Property (same as last month).
- Primary Causes of roadway accidents were **Failure to Yield** (4), **Improper Start/Stop** (3), and **Improper Turn** (3).
- Primary Cause of private property accidents was **Improper Backing** (4).
- 8 of the roadway accidents happened on Forest Dr., and 5 on N. Treholm Rd.
- 5 of the 10 private property accidents happened at businesses on Forest Drive.
